Welcome to the Victorian Interfaith Networks Festival, hosted by Boroondara Interfaith Network and City of Boroondara in association with the Faith Communities Council of Victoria.

This annual event aims to help build the capacity and sustainability of existing multifaith and interfaith networks, bring people up-to-date with current

matters, provide networking opportunities, and assist the hosting council and network to promote its work to the local community.

Luna's will discuss his refugee journey and what created a sense of belonging for him in regional Victoria.
